In support of the National Day of Truth and Reconciliation and on behalf of the survivors of residential schools, we are thrilled that Scott Collegiate students will be attending **Miyo-wic'iwitowin Day on Thursday, September 29, 2022, in Mosaic Stadium** located on Treaty 4 Territory.

Miyo-wic'iwitowin Day is our response to the Federal Government's declaration of September 30 as the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, a statutory holiday to pause and reflect on the tragic history and ongoing trauma of residential schools.

#### **Pre-Event Preparations**

As this is an outdoor event, students and staff are asked to dress appropriately for the weather.

- Proper headwear for a sunny day
- Rainproof or rain-resistant coat if there is the potential of inclement weather.

For ease of access and to support a safe environment, all attendees are strongly encouraged not to bring bags or backpacks to the event, where possible. Special accommodations will be made for attendees with special medical needs.

#### **TRC Event Ambassadors**

Event Ambassadors will be assigned to Scott Collegiate to ensure all students have an outstanding experience at Miyo-wic'iwitowin Day. These ambassadors will meet the busses to greet you, lead you to your seats and be a support to you throughout the event.

### Program Timelines

- 9:15 AM Gates Open and Student Arrival Begins**
- Due to the high volume of students and the likelihood of bus trips required to transport all Regina High School students, any schools that arrive in advance of 9:15 AM will be granted early access.
- 10:30 AM Programming Begins**
- All attendees are encouraged to be in their seats by 10:20 AM
- 11:40 AM Lunch**
- A complimentary bagged lunch will be provided to students.
  - Students with dietary restrictions are encouraged to bring an alternative lunch.
  - Due to Mosaic Stadium's no re-entry policy, students will not be permitted to exit the stadium and return during the lunch break.

- 1:30 PM Programming Ends**

### Photography

There will be photographers capturing this inaugural event. Please ensure parents/guardians are notified of the photography in case any wish to decline their child's involvement. Your Ambassador will provide brightly coloured wristbands for children not permitted to be photographed. All photographers will be advised of the wristbands and instructed not to photograph these students. Additionally, an aerial photo of all participants will be structured during this momentous day; students with wristbands will need to leave the area in order to guarantee not to be captured. Your Ambassador will assist with this.

### Transportation Drop-Off & Parking

Your transportation will be requested to unload students in REAL District's pre-configured bus lanes. Bus entry and lane locations will be communicated to all bussing companies in advance of September 29. We ask the schools to remain on your bus until your Ambassador meets you. Any teachers or administrators accompanying the students that arrive by personal vehicle are required to enter REAL District via the Lewvan Gate and follow the directive of REAL's Parking Attendants over to parking lot D.

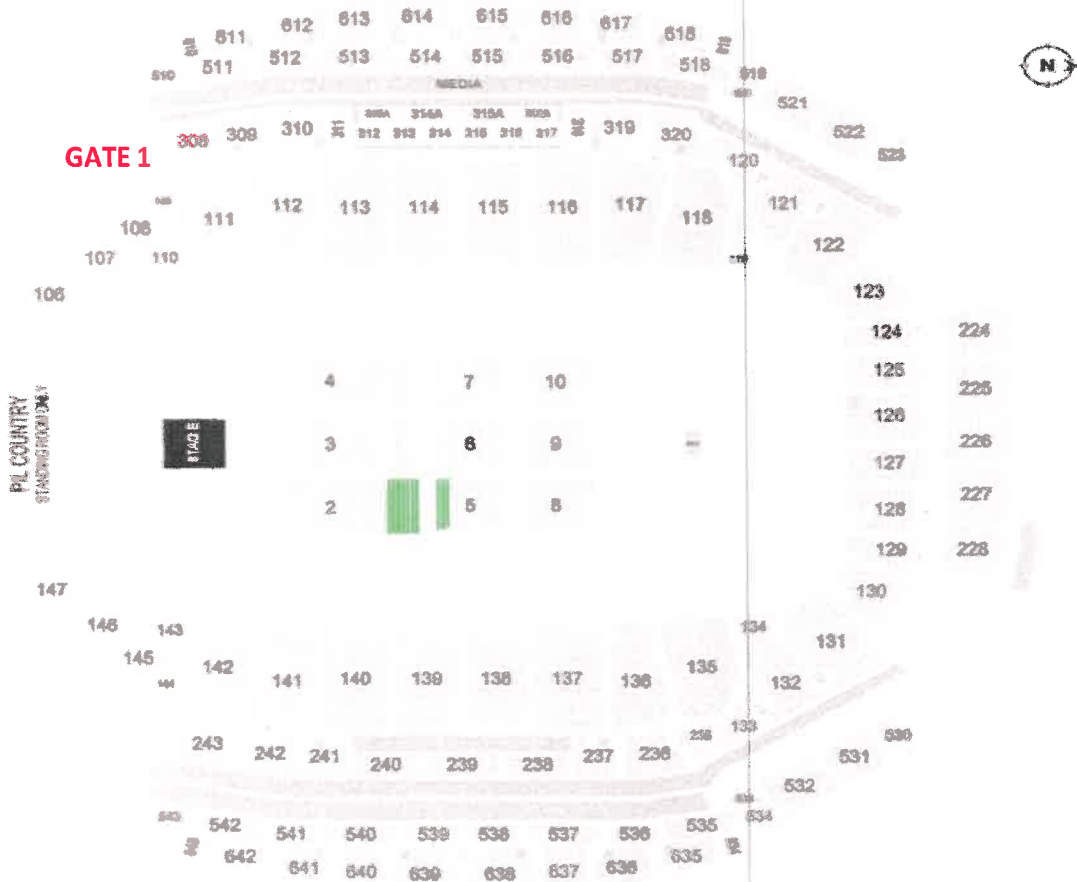

### Gate Entry & Seating

All Scott Collegiate attendees are asked to follow your TRC Ambassador and enter through **GATE 1**. For the safety and security of all attendees, bag screening prior to entry will be in effect. We encourage all students to bring only what they need and leave backpacks at school, if able.

Upon arrival, an event ambassador assigned to your school will meet you and assist your school to your seats. All Scott Collegiate attendees will enter through **GATE 1** and be seated in **floor sections 2 and 5**. We ask that Scott Collegiate attendees only sit in the assigned seats. If there are any challenges with your seating, your TRC Event Ambassadors will be there to assist.
